


# Site maps of the Royal Sussex County Hospital, the Royal Alexandra Hospital and the Sussex Eye Hospital



1. **Main Eastern Road entrance** for most wards, x-ray and MRI, breast unit, ENT and audiology outpatients and cardiology.
2. **Latilla entrance** for physiotherapy and rheumatology outpatients.
3. **Cancer Centre entrance** for chemotherapy and radiotherapy.
4. **Emergency entrance and Thomas Kemp Tower** for accident and emergency, maternity, CT scanning, orthopaedic outpatients.
5. **Millennium Wing** for cardiac surgery, orthopaedic surgery and digestive diseases.
6. **Sussex Kidney Unit** and multi-storey car park.
7. **Royal Alexandra Children's Hospital**
8. **Sussex Eye Hospital entrance for eye inpatients** (via Eastern Road).
9. **Sussex Eye Hospital entrance for eye outpatients** (via Sudeley Terrace).
10. **Outpatients Department** for most medical and surgical outpatients, diabetes, blood tests, colposcopy and genito-urinary medicine.
11. **Lawson Unit.**
12. **Sussex House** for urology (including outpatients), Clinical Media Centre and the Elton John centre.
13. **Sussex House Mobile Breast Screening Unit.** At the back of car park, access via Abbey Road.

## How to get to the hospitals

**Parking:** Parking is limited, so please use public transport when possible. The parking facilities available are as follows:

The multi-storey car park is situated on the North Access Road which is accessed from Bristol gate third entry on the left travelling up Bristol Gate (immediately after the A & E entrance). The multi-storey has 20 disabled bays located on Level 6 which gives direct access into the hospital and 6 dedicated renal bays for regular renal patients.

There are 4 drop off/pick-up bays located next to the multi-storey car park (these are primarily for the use of parents/guardians dropping children off for the Royal Alexandra Children's Hospital).

There is limited access to the A&E forecourt with 4 drop-off bays and 2 disabled bays.

At the front of the main hospital site there is a pay and display car park for patients and visitors only - this has 12 disabled bays outside the Physiotherapy Department (Latilla building) and 5 disabled bays by the car park entrance.

Please note car parking charges apply to all users, including disabled.

**Bus:** Routes 1, 7, 37 and 25c all stop outside the hospital

**The 40X bus service:** For travelling between hospital sites, there is the 40X bus service that runs between the Princess Royal Hospital and Royal Sussex County Hospital sites on an hourly basis. This service is free to patients carrying their appointment letter.

**Bluebird service:** The Bluebird bus is a door to door transport service for patients. The bus runs from 8am to 6pm, Monday to Friday. You can book the bus in advance by contacting Bluebird on 01444 471919 (mornings only) or through the Trust's Transport Bureau. The cost is £6 per return journey or £4 per single journey.

**Train:** The nearest train station is Brighton.

The RSCH is built on a steep slope and has a number of stairs and lifts connecting the Main Block, Thomas Kemp Tower, RACH and Millenium Wing. Once you arrive at the main hospital site there will be signs for you to follow to the building you need.
